THELMA MCMILLEN RECOVERY CENTER TEEN PROGRAM

Part of Torrance Memorial Medical Center, the Thelma McMillen Recovery Center offers an intensive outpatient alcohol and drug treatment program for adolescents, serving youth ages 13 through 17. It is designed for adolescents who need an intensive and structured program to get back on a healthy path, but do not require inpatient care.

The Thelma McMillen Recovery Center Teen Program comprises a multidisciplinary treatment team dedicated to treating the whole person – mind, body, and spirit. Team members include:

- Psychiatrists
- Psychologists
- Marriage and Family Therapists
- Certified Chemical Dependency Counselors

Incorporating a combination of individual, group, and family counseling, along with educational, mentoring, and support programs, the Thelma McMillen Recovery Center Outpatient Program is divided into three separate phases:

- Phase I Intensive Care
- Phase II Transitional Care
- Phase III Continuing Care

At every phase of treatment, the individual will continue to remain in school, live within the family home, recover within their real life environment, and learn to develop a healthy lifestyle. Family involvement at every phase is a key to helping return to a full and rewarding life without drugs and alcohol.
